| WHEREAS: | While many parents or caregivers choose to participate in programming and education services alone or with their partner, children are often invited to join in these learning opportunities, too; and |
| WHEREAS: | ECFE is provided by teachers who are licensed in early childhood and/or parenting education by the state of Minnesota; and |
| WHEREAS: | April 11, 2024, marks the 50 th anniversary of ECFE in Minnesota; For half a century, ECFE has evolved through programs, partnerships, and initiatives, always working in service of stronger families and the healthy growth and development of children; and |
